Franjo Pehar is assistant professor at the University of Zadar's Department of Information Sciences and head of the Laboratory for Interactive Systems and User Experience (UNIZD UX Lab). His research interests include history and theory of information science, scholarly communication, bibliometrics, information retrieval, human-computer interaction, usability, and user experience.

Franjo Pehar was born on October 29, 1975, in Basel, Switzerland. He is employed at the Department of Information Sciences of the University of Zadar as an assistant professor the field information and communication sciences.

In 1999, he earned his first master's degree in Sociology and Croatian studies at the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Croatian Studies. His master's thesis was titled: "Library of the Monastery of the Little Friars in Dubrovnik" (Public Defense: 1999. Mentor: Prof. Franjo Šanjek. Area: Social Sciences; Field: Sociology / Field: Interdisciplinary areas of sciences; Field: Croatian studies), and in 2000 he received his master's degree in Librarianship from the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Zagreb (Master thesis title: "Change management in public libraries". He founded the Laboratory for Interactive Systems and User Experience (UX Lab Zadar) with a group of colleagues from the Department of Information Sciences, and he is now in charge of it.
